SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-699.15 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm license plates to any Illinois resident who has earned the Southwest Asia Service Medal from the United States Armed Forces. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 3-699.15 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.15 new)

Sec. 3-699.15. Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm
 license plates.

9 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special 10 registration plates designated as Operation Desert 11 12 Shield/Desert Storm license plates to any Illinois resident who has earned the Southwest Asia Service Medal from the United 13 14 States Armed Forces. The special plates issued under this Section may be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first 15 16 division, motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this 17 Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year 18 19 procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

20 <u>(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be</u> 21 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate 22 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, and the 23 appropriate registration fee shall accompany the application.
