The 11 12 game shall commence on January 1, 2019 or as soon thereafter, at the discretion of the Director, as is reasonably practical. 13 The operation of the game shall be governed by this Act and any 14 15 rules adopted by the Department. If any provision of this Section is inconsistent with any other provision of this Act, 16

2 (b) The net revenue from the State police memorials 3 scratch-off game shall be deposited into the <u>following funds</u> 4 <del>Criminal Justice Information Projects Fund and distributed</del> 5 <del>equally,</del> as soon as practical but at least on a monthly basis<u>:</u>, 6 <del>to</del>

7 (1) One-third shall be deposited into the Chicago
 8 Police Memorial Foundation Fund. 7

9 <u>(2) One-third shall be deposited into</u> the Police 10 Memorial Committee Fund<u>, and</u>

<u>(3) One-third shall be deposited into</u> the Illinois
 State Police Memorial Park Fund.

Moneys deposited into transferred to the funds under this 13 14 Section shall be used, subject to appropriation, to fund grants 15 for building and maintaining memorials and parks; holding 16 memorial commemorations; giving scholarships annual to children of officers killed or catastrophically injured in the 17 18 line of duty, or those interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement; providing financial assistance to police officers 19 20 and their families when a police officer is killed or injured 21 in the line of duty; and providing financial assistance to 22 officers for the purchase or replacement of bullet proof vests 23 to be used in the line of duty.

For purposes of this subsection, "net revenue" means the total amount for which tickets have been sold less the sum of the amount paid out in the prizes and the actual administrative 1 expenses of the Department solely related to the scratch-off 2 game under this Section.

3 (c) During the time that tickets are sold for the State 4 police memorials scratch-off game, the Department shall not 5 unreasonably diminish the efforts devoted to marketing any 6 other instant scratch-off lottery game.

7 (d) The Department may adopt any rules necessary to
8 implement and administer the provisions of this Section.
