Streicher dreamed of being 6 a police officer at a young age; he started as a Police 7 Explorer in high school and later attended college to earn a 8 criminal justice degree while working as a Code Enforcer for 9 the City of Kewanee; and 10 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Adam Streicher worked for the 11 Villages of Atkinson, Sheffield, and Annawan, which was his 12 hometown, before accepting employment as a Sheriff's Deputy for 13 Stark County in 2001; and 14 WHEREAS, On March 22, 2002, Deputy Sheriff Adam Streicher was shot and killed while attempting to serve a failure to pay 15 16 warrant; and 17 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Adam Streicher attended Annawan 18 High School along with other fallen police officers Master Sergeant Stanley W. Talbot and Michigan State Trooper Chad H.
