WHEREAS, An omphalocele is a birth defect that occurs early 2 3 in pregnancy in which the abdominal wall does not close 4 properly and some or most of the abdominal organs protrude into 5 the umbilical cord; and 6 WHEREAS, It is estimated that a small omphalocele occurs in 7 about one out of every 5,000 pregnancies and a large or giant 8 omphalocele occurs in about one out of everv 10,000 9 pregnancies; and 10 omphalocele may be isolated or WHEREAS, An associated with other defects or chromosomal abnormalities; 11 12 and 13 WHEREAS, Despite the challenges a baby born with an 14 omphalocele may face, many babies who are born with an 15 omphalocele survive and go on to live happy, healthy lives; and 16 WHEREAS, Mothers of Omphaloceles (MOO) is a group of over 17 2,000 parents from around the world that was created to provide 18 hope and information to families with babies diagnosed with an omphalocele; therefore, be it 19
