SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, In the first two months of 2017, anti-Semitic 3 events have been on the rise throughout the United States; 4 these events are attempts to incite fear and disrupt daily life 5 in peaceful communities; and

6 WHEREAS, This trend has been seen in Illinois when The Loop 7 Synagogue in Chicago was vandalized in early February with 8 broken windows and anti-Semitic graffiti that included 9 swastikas; and

10 WHEREAS, The Chesed Shel Emeth Society cemetery near St. 11 Louis, Missouri, which dates back to the late 1800s, was 12 vandalized over the President's Day weekend with more than 150 13 tombstones damaged or toppled over, an example of a 14 long-standing, anti-Semitic practice of desecrating cemeteries; and 15

16 WHEREAS, One week later, the Mount Carmel Jewish Cemetery 17 in northeastern Philadelphia, Pennsylvania was vandalized with 18 as many as 500 headstones knocked over or damaged; and

19 WHEREAS, A bomb threat was made to the Hyde Park Jewish 20 Community Center, one of more than 50 phoned threats to these 21 facilities in cities across the nation in recent weeks; and 1 WHEREAS, In spite of actions taken against groups based on 2 race, religion, or ethnic origin in our country's history, 3 America has always come together to denounce and overcome hate 4 and stand united for tolerance and inclusion; therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL 6 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we condemn these acts 7 of hate and fear, that we will respond to this latest wave of 8 threats with love and assistance to victims of these acts, and 9 that we will work tirelessly as individuals and a legislative 10 body to encourage peace and acceptance in every community in 11 our great State.
