2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 54 on page 1, line
3	14, by inserting after the period the following:
4	"No less than 30 days before the issuance of a warrant under
5	this subsection, a notice shall be mailed to the offender by
6	first class mail to the most recent address which the offender
7	has provided to the court. The notice shall contain the

9	(1) the amount of the fine which is due and owing;
10	(2) the docket number of the case in which the fine was
