Section 5. The Flag Display Act is amended by adding
Section 20 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 20. Honor and Remember Flag.</u>

8 <u>(a) The Honor and Remember Flag is designated as the symbol</u> 9 <u>of our State's concern and commitment to honoring and</u> 10 <u>remembering all members of the United States Armed Forces who</u> 11 <u>have lost their lives while serving our country in the line of</u> 12 <u>duty and their families.</u>

13 (b) The Honor and Remember Flag may be displayed at the 14 State Capitol Building, other appropriate State-owned 15 buildings and facilities, each circuit court building, and each 16 city and town hall on the following days:

(1) Armed Forces Day, the third Saturday in May;

- 19 <u>(3) Flag Day, June 14;</u>
- 20 (4) Independence Day, July 4;
- 21 (5) National POW/MIA Recognition Day, the third Friday

3	(8) a day on which a member of the United States Armed

9	(c) When displayed, the Honor and Remember Flag shall be
10	displayed in a manner designed to ensure visibility to the
11	public, but shall not be flown above or take precedence over
12	the United States national flag, the Illinois State flag, or a
13	POW/MIA flag. An Honor and Remember Flag displayed under this
14	Section must be manufactured in the United States.
15	(d) This Section shall not be construed so as to require
16	any employee to report to work solely for the purpose of
17	providing for the display of the Honor and Remember Flag.
18	(e) The head of each Department, agency, or other
19	governmental entity responsible for a location at which an
20	Honor and Remember Flag is displayed under this Section may use
21	public funds to procure and display Honor and Remember Flags.
22	(f) The head of each Department, agency, or other
23	governmental entity responsible for a location at which an
24	Honor and Remember Flag is displayed under this Section may
25	adopt rules as necessary to carry-out the requirements of this
26	Section.
