

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. References to Act. This Act may be referred to
5 as Adam's Law.

6 Section 5. The Disposition of Remains Act is amended by
7 changing Section 50 as follows:

8 (755 ILCS 65/50)

9 Sec. 50. Disputes. Any dispute among any of the persons
10 listed in Section 5 concerning their right to control the
11 disposition, including cremation, of a decedent's remains
12 shall be resolved by a court of competent jurisdiction within
13 30 days of the dispute being filed with the court. A cemetery
14 organization or funeral establishment shall not be liable for
15 refusing to accept the decedent's remains, or to inter or
16 otherwise dispose of the decedent's remains, until it receives
17 a court order or other suitable confirmation that the dispute
18 has been resolved or settled.
