9 Sec. 50. Disputes. Any dispute among any of the persons 10 listed in Section 5 concerning their right to control the disposition, including cremation, of a decedent's remains 11 shall be resolved by a court of competent jurisdiction within 12 13 30 days of the dispute being filed with the court. A cemetery organization or funeral establishment shall not be liable for 14 15 refusing to accept the decedent's remains, or to inter or otherwise dispose of the decedent's remains, until it receives 16 a court order or other suitable confirmation that the dispute 17 18 has been resolved or settled.
