Amends the Counties Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning county board elections.

AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section
2-3002.5 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/2-3002.5)

7 Sec. 2-3002.5. Beginning with members elected at the the 8 general election in 2002, counties having a population between 9 800,000 and 3,000,000 according to 2000 decennial census shall 10 have no more than 18 members on their county board. If the chairman of the county board is elected at-large by the voters 11 of the county as provided in Section 2-3007, the chairman shall 12 13 not be counted as a member of the county board for the purpose 14 of the limitations on the size of the county board provided in this Section. Neither a member nor the chairman of that county 15 16 board shall serve simultaneously as commissioner or president 17 of the board of commissioners of the forest preserve district. No person shall seek election to both the county board and the 18 19 forest preserve commission at the same election.
