Sec. 10.12. Police dog training standards. All Beginning July 1, 2012, all police dogs used by State and local law enforcement agencies for drug enforcement purposes under pursuant to the Cannabis Control Act (720 ILCS 550/), the Illinois Controlled Substances Act (720 ILCS 570/), and the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act (720 ILCS 646/) shall be trained by programs that meet the minimum certification requirements set by the Board. On or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General

Assembly, notwithstanding any provision of law, police dogs

- used by State and local law enforcement agencies for drug 1
- enforcement purposes under the Cannabis Control Act may be 2
- trained by programs that meet the minimum certification 3
- 4 requirements set by the Board.
