Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning unlawful practices.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business

  Practices Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 262)
- Sec. 2. Unfair methods of competition and and unfair or 8 deceptive acts or practices, including but not limited to the 9 use or employment of any deception fraud, false pretense, false promise, misrepresentation or the concealment, suppression or 10 omission of any material fact, with intent that others rely 11 upon the concealment, suppression or omission of such material 12 fact, or the use or employment of any practice described in 13 14 Section 2 of the "Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act", approved August 5, 1965, in the conduct of any trade or 15 16 commerce are hereby declared unlawful whether any person has in 17 fact been misled, deceived or damaged thereby. In construing section consideration shall 18 be given 19 interpretations of the Federal Trade Commission and the federal 20 courts relating to Section 5 (a) of the Federal Trade 21 Commission Act.
