SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/11-1.25 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Provides that a person commits sexual assault by deception if the person commits an act of sexual penetration and the person submits under the belief that the person committing the act is someone known to the victim other than the accused, and this belief is induced by pretense or concealment by the accused with the intent to induce that belief. Sexual assault by deception is a Class 3 felony.

CORRECTIONAL BUDGET AND IMPACT NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by adding Section 11-1.25 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 11-1.25. Sexual assault by deception.
- 8 (a) A person commits sexual assault by deception if the
 9 person commits an act of sexual penetration and the person
 10 submits under the belief that the person committing the act is
 11 someone known to the victim other than the accused, and this
 12 belief is induced by pretense or concealment by the accused
- with the intent to induce that belief.
- (b) Sentence. Sexual assault by deception is a Class 3
- 15 <u>felony</u>.
