## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-13 new

Amends the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act of the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that new redevelopment project areas may not be established under the Act until 2 years after the effective date of the amendatory Act. Repeals the provisions 2 years after the effective date of the amendatory Act. Effective immediately.

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
Section 11-74.4-13 as follows:

(65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-13 new) 6 7 Sec. 11-74.4-13. Two-year moratorium on new redevelopment 8 project areas. 9 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, new redevelopment project areas may not be established under this 10 Act until 2 years after the effective date of this amendatory 11 12 Act of the 101st General Assembly. (b) This Section is repealed 2 years after the effective 13 14 date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly. 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
