## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.891 new 30 ILCS 105/5.893 new 625 ILCS 5/3-699.14

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code to allow for the issuance of decals for Universal special license plates by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers and its Local Lodge 701. Provides fees for the issuance of the decals. Creates the Guide Dogs of America Fund and the Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund as special funds in the State treasury. Makes corresponding changes in the State Finance Act.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding 5 Sections 5.891 and 5.893 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.891 new)
- 7 Sec. 5.891. The Guide Dogs of America Fund.
- 8 (30 ILCS 105/5.893 new)
- 9 Sec. 5.893. The Mechanics Training Fund.

Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing Section 3-699.14 as follows:

12 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14)

13 Sec. 3-699.14. Universal special license plates.

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications
made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue
Universal special license plates to residents of Illinois on
behalf of organizations that have been authorized by the
General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special license
plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by the

Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized 1 2 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this Section. 3 When applying for a Universal special license plate the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the 4 5 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record 6 of that organization and that organization shall remain 7 8 affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered, 9 revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization 10 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and 11 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the 12 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct from 13 any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal, sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal 14 15 special license plate other than a decal authorized by the 16 General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal 17 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 18 19 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates 20 issued under this Section shall expire according to the 21 22 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of

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1 Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for the 2 application of a decal to the plate. Organizations authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special 3 license plates shall comply with rules adopted by the Secretary 4 5 governing the requirements for and approval of Universal special license plate decals. The Secretary may, in his or her 6 discretion, allow Universal special license plates to be issued 7 8 as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 9 3-405.1 of this Code. The Secretary of State must make a 10 version of the special registration plates authorized under 11 this Section in a form appropriate for motorcycles and 12 autocycles.

13 (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate, the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee is 14 15 to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged, the 16 amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed. When 17 necessary, the authorizing language shall create a special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be deposited for an 18 19 authorized Universal special license plate. Additional fees 20 may only be charged if the fee is to be paid over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in compliance with the 21 22 registration and reporting requirements of the Charitable 23 Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act. Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal special license 24 25 plates shall annually provide the Secretary of State a letter 26 of compliance issued by the Attorney General verifying that the

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entity is in compliance with the Charitable Trust Act and the
 Solicitation for Charity Act.

3 Upon original issuance and for each registration (d) renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration 4 5 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license 6 plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of 7 the 8 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the 9 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State 10 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into 11 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the 12 organization to issue decals for Universal special license plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed 13 14 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General 15 Assembly.

(e) The following organizations may issue decals for
Universal special license plates with the original and renewal
fees and fee distribution as follows:

 21 Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund and \$15 to the Secretary
 22 of State Special License Plate Fund.

(B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Roadside Monarch
Habitat Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special
License Plate Fund.

26 (2) Illinois Veterans' Homes.

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Original issuance: \$26, which shall 1 (A) be deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund. 2 3 (B) Renewal: \$26, which shall be deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund. 4 5 (3) The Illinois Department of Human Services for 6 volunteerism decals. 7 (A) Original issuance: \$25, which shall be 8 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License 9 Plate Fund. 10 (B) Renewal: \$25, which shall be deposited into the 11 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. 12 (4) The Illinois Department of Public Health. 13 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the 14 Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the Secretary 15 of State Special License Plate Fund. 16 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Prostate Cancer 17 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. 18 (5) Horsemen's Council of Illinois. 19 20 Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to (A) the 21 Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund and \$15 to the 22 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. 23 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of 24 25 State Special License Plate Fund. 26 (6) The International Association of Machinists

3	Guide Dogs of America Fund and \$15 to the Secretary
4	of State Special License Plate Fund.
5	(B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 going to the Guide

7	State Special License Plate Fund.
8	(7) Local Lodge 701 of the International
9	Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers.
10	(A) Original issuance: \$35; with \$10 to the
11	Guide Dogs of America Fund, \$10 to the Mechanics
12	Training Fund, and \$15 to the Secretary of State
13	Special License Plate Fund.
14	(B) Renewal: \$30; with \$13 to the Guide Dogs of
15	America Fund, \$15 to the Mechanics Training Fund,
16	and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special License
17	Plate Fund.
18	(f) The following funds are created as special funds in the
19	State treasury:
20	(1) The Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund. All moneys to be

21 paid as grants to the Illinois Department of Natural 22 Resources to fund roadside monarch and other pollinator 23 habitat development, enhancement, and restoration projects 24 in this State.

(2) The Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund. All moneys to
 be paid as grants to the Prostate Cancer Foundation of

Chicago. 1 (3) The Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund. All moneys 2 shall be paid as grants to the Horsemen's Council of 3 Illinois. 4 (4) The Guide Dogs of America Fund. All moneys shall be 5 paid as grants to the International Guiding Eyes, Inc., 6 7 doing business as Guide Dogs of America. (5) The Mechanics Training Fund. All moneys shall be 8 9 paid as grants to the Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund.
