SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/60

Amends the Firearms Concealed Carry Act. Provides that for a new or renewal concealed carry license, the fee shall be \$100 (rather than \$150), of which \$80 (rather than \$120) shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$15 (rather than \$20) shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$5 (rather than \$10) shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by 5 changing Section 60 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 66/60)

7 Sec. 60. Fees.

8 (a) All fees collected under this Act shall be deposited as 9 provided in this Section. Application, renewal, and 10 replacement fees shall be non-refundable.

11 (b) An applicant for a new license or a renewal shall 12 submit $\frac{100}{100}$ $\frac{150}{100}$ with the application, of which $\frac{80}{100}$ $\frac{120}{120}$ shall 13 be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, $\frac{15}{20}$ 14 $\frac{20}{10}$ shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, 15 and $\frac{55}{10}$ shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory 16 Fund.

(c) A non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$300 with the application, of which \$250 shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$40 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

(d) A licensee requesting a new license in accordance with
Section 55 shall submit \$75, of which \$60 shall be apportioned

apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall
3 be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
