SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 722/17 new

Amends the Missing Persons Identification Act. Provides that the law enforcement agency official, coroner, medical examiner, or other person who makes a public statement concerning the identification of human remains must report both the biological sex, based on the genitalia of the human remains, and the likely gender of the person based on the chosen appearance of the deceased.

4 Section 5. The Missing Persons Identification Act is 5 amended by adding Section 17 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 722/17 new) 7 Sec. 17. Reporting human remains by law enforcement. The law enforcement agency official, coroner, medical examiner, or 8 9 other person who makes a public statement concerning the 10 identification of human remains must report both the biological sex, based on the genitalia of the human remains, and the 11 12 likely gender of the person based on the chosen appearance of the deceased. 13
