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backgrounds. For this reason, a mobile tolerance education center's utility is widespread, as it will be able to engage all age groups and cater workshops to impact everyone, including students, educators, law enforcement, business and community leaders, and the government.

6 (b) The purpose of this Act is for the Simon Wiesenthal 7 Center, with over 40 years of educational experience and fighting for human rights, to build 2 mobile tolerance 8 9 education centers to teach students and other individuals about 10 topics of diversity, democracy, civic rights, the and 11 responsibility. A mobile tolerance education center will be a 35-seat, fully accessible, state-of-the-art, technologically 12 13 advanced mobile education center that presents information on the effects and consequences of hate and intolerance. The 14 15 experience will travel throughout this State, via 2 centers, 16 educating people from different backgrounds and experiences. 17 It will provide education on historical events and instances 18 of inequality and intolerance and will interact with students 19 on how these events are relevant to both American and global 20 perspectives of intolerance.".
