SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 147/35

Amends the School Visitation Rights Act. Prohibits an employer from terminating an employee because of an absence from work due to employee's attendance at a school conference or activity. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Visitation Rights Act is amended by changing Section 35 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 147/35)
- 7 Sec. 35. Employee rights.
- general No employee shall lose any employee benefits, except as provided for in Section 20 of this Act, for exercising his or her rights under this Act. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to affect an employer's obligation to comply with any collective bargaining agreement or employee benefit plan.

 Nothing in this Act shall prevent an employer from providing school visitation rights in excess of the requirements of this
- 15 Act. The rights afforded by this Act shall not be diminished by
- any collective bargaining act or by any employee benefit plan.
- 17 (b) An employer may not terminate an employee for an
- 18 <u>absence from work if the absence is due to the employee's</u>
- 19 <u>attendance at a school conference or activity.</u>
