1 be granted to the employee except sick leave and disability 2 leave. Before arranging attendance at the conference or activity, the employee shall provide the employer with a 3 4 written request for leave at least 7 days in advance of the 5 time the employee is required to utilize the visitation right. 6 In emergency situations, no more than 24 hours' hours notice shall be required. The employee must consult with the employer 7 to schedule the leave so as not to disrupt unduly the 8 9 operations of the employer.

(b) Nothing in this Act requires that the leave be paid.

11 (c) For regularly scheduled, nonemergency visitations, 12 schools shall make time available for visitation during both 13 regular school hours and evening hours.
