1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2830

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2830 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The School Visitation Rights Act is amended by
5 changing Section 15 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 147/15)

7 Sec. 15. School conference and activity leave.

8 (a) An employer must grant an employee leave of up to a
9 total of 16 ~~8~~ hours during any school year, and no more than 4
10 hours of which may be taken on any given day, to attend school
11 conferences or classroom activities related to the employee's
12 child if the conference or classroom activities cannot be
13 scheduled during nonwork hours; however, no leave may be taken
14 by an employee of an employer that is subject to this Act
15 unless the employee has exhausted all accrued vacation leave,
16 personal leave, compensatory leave and any other leave that may

1 be granted to the employee except sick leave and disability
2 leave. Before arranging attendance at the conference or
3 activity, the employee shall provide the employer with a
4 written request for leave at least 7 days in advance of the
5 time the employee is required to utilize the visitation right.
6 In emergency situations, no more than 24 hours' ~~hours~~ notice
7 shall be required. The employee must consult with the employer
8 to schedule the leave so as not to disrupt unduly the
9 operations of the employer.

10 (b) Nothing in this Act requires that the leave be paid.

11 (c) For regularly scheduled, nonemergency visitations,
12 schools shall make time available for visitation during both
13 regular school hours and evening hours.
