AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 3. The Property Tax Code is amended by adding 5 Section 9-195.1 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 200/9-195.1 new) 7 Sec. 9-195.1. Leases of certain real property. If the property located at 558 West De Koven Street in Chicago becomes 8 9 an asset of the Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund by operation of Section 6-165.3 of the Illinois Pension Code, and if the 10 Fund subsequently leases the property to an entity whose 11 12 property is not exempt, then the leasehold estate and the appurtenances shall be listed as the property of the lessee or 13 14 his or her assignee. Taxes on that property shall be collected 15 in the same manner as on property that is not exempt, and the 16 lessee shall be liable for those taxes. However, no tax lien 17 shall attach to the exempt real estate.

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding Section 6-165.3 as follows:

1 discontinues use of the property located at 558 West De Koven 2 Street in Chicago as an academy for the training of 3 firefighters, the city shall, as soon as practicable, transfer the property to the Fund. The transferred property shall be 4 5 considered an asset of the Fund, but shall not be considered as part of the city's required contribution under Section 6-165 in 6 7 any year or to meet the funding obligation under Section 8 6-165.2 in any year. In administering the asset, the Fund shall 9 exercise its fiduciary duties; however, in accordance with 10 those fiduciary duties, the Fund shall prioritize uses that add 11 value to the Chicago Fire Department and its membership. If the 12 property is transferred to the Fund, the Fund may not sell that property without the affirmative vote of the three-fifths of 13 14 the members of the board. The conveyance of the property located at 558 West De Koven Street in Chicago is an exclusive 15 16 power and function of the State. This Section is a denial and limitation of home rule powers under subsection (h) of Section 17 <u>6 of Article VII of the Illin</u>ois Constitution. 18

Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding Section 8.43 as follows:

 Sec. 8.43. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
