- (b) Upon the adoption of an ordinance by the city council
 of the municipality requesting a referendum to incur additional
- legal expenses, a referendum, subject to the requirements of
- 16 16-7 of the Election Code, shall be placed on the ballot for
- 17 all electors residing in the municipality at the next general
- 18 <u>election in substantially the following form:</u>
