1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3469

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3469, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No.
4 1, as follows:

5 on page 4, line 22, by replacing "three" with "four"; and

6 on page 4, line 23, after "labor community," by inserting
7 "environmental community,"; and

8 on page 5, by replacing lines 6 through 9 with the following:

9 "(9) the Director of Employment Security, or his or her
10 designee;

11 (10) the Superintendent of the State Board of
12 Education, or his or her designee; and

13 (11) the Director of the Illinois Community College
14 Board, or his or her designee."; and

1 on page 5, line 11, by replacing "January 31, 2021" with
2 "February 28, 2021"; and

3 on page 6, line 2, by replacing "November 1, 2021" with
4 "December 1, 2021"; and

5 on page 31, line 23, after the period, by inserting "This
6 Section is repealed one year after the effective date of this
7 amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly."; and

8 on page 89, by replacing lines 1 through 8 with "1, 2015.
9 Nothing shall be deemed to prohibit an individual from using
10 this site to determine a Firearm Owner's Identification Card
11 status. The Department shall adopt rules not inconsistent with
12 this Section to implement this system."; and

13 by replacing line 17 on page 92 through line 22 on page 94 with
14 the following:

15 "(430 ILCS 65/6) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-6)

16 Sec. 6. Contents of Firearm Owner's Identification Card.

17 (a) A Firearm Owner's Identification Card, issued by the
18 Department of State Police at such places as the Director of
19 the Department shall specify, shall contain the applicant's
20 name, residence, date of birth, sex, physical description,

1 recent photograph, except as provided in subsection (c-5), and
2 signature. Each Firearm Owner's Identification Card must have
3 the expiration date boldly and conspicuously displayed on the
4 face of the card, unless the validity has been extended under
5 subsection (b) of Section 7. Each Firearm Owner's
6 Identification Card must have printed on it the following:
7 "CAUTION - This card does not permit bearer to UNLAWFULLY carry
8 or use firearms." Before December 1, 2002, the Department may
9 use a person's digital photograph and signature from his or her
10 Illinois driver's license or Illinois Identification Card, if
11 available. On and after December 1, 2002, the Department shall
12 use a person's digital photograph and signature from his or her
13 Illinois driver's license or Illinois Identification Card, if
14 available. The Department shall decline to use a person's
15 digital photograph or signature if the digital photograph or
16 signature is the result of or associated with fraudulent or
17 erroneous data, unless otherwise provided by law.

18 (b) A person applying for a Firearm Owner's Identification
19 Card shall consent to the Department of State Police using the
20 applicant's digital driver's license or Illinois
21 Identification Card photograph, if available, and signature on
22 the applicant's Firearm Owner's Identification Card. The
23 Secretary of State shall allow the Department of State Police
24 access to the photograph and signature for the purpose of
25 identifying the applicant and issuing to the applicant a
26 Firearm Owner's Identification Card.

1 (c) The Secretary of State shall conduct a study to
2 determine the cost and feasibility of creating a method of
3 adding an identifiable code, background, or other means on the
4 driver's license or Illinois Identification Card to show that
5 an individual is not disqualified from owning or possessing a
6 firearm under State or federal law. The Secretary shall report
7 the findings of this study 12 months after the effective date
8 of this amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly.

9 (c-5) If a person qualifies for a photograph exemption, in
10 lieu of a photograph, the Firearm Owner's Identification Card
11 shall contain a copy of the card holder's fingerprints. Each
12 Firearm Owner's Identification Card described in this
13 subsection (c-5) must have printed on it the following: "This
14 card is only valid for firearm purchases through a federally
15 licensed firearms dealer when presented with photographic
16 identification, as prescribed by 18 U.S.C. 922(t)(1)(C)."
