#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

70 ILCS 3615/3A.19 new

Amends the Regional Transportation Authority Act. Provides that the Suburban Bus Board shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an annual report on all procurement goals and actual spending for female-owned, minority-owned, and veteran-owned enterprises in the previous calendar year. Provides that the Suburban Bus Board shall hold an annual workshop open to the public on the state of supplier diversity. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Regional Transportation Authority Act is  
5 amended by adding Section 3A.19 as follows:

6 (70 ILCS 3615/3A.19 new)

7 Sec. 3A.19. Procurement reports. The Suburban Bus Board  
8 shall submit an annual report to the Governor and the General  
9 Assembly by April 15, 2020, and by every April 15 thereafter,  
10 in a searchable Adobe PDF format, on all procurement goals and  
11 actual spending for female-owned, minority-owned, and  
12 veteran-owned enterprises in the previous calendar year. These  
13 goals shall be expressed as a percentage of the total work  
14 performed by the entity submitting the report, and the actual  
15 spending for all female-owned, minority-owned, and  
16 veteran-owned enterprises shall also be expressed as a  
17 percentage of the total work performed by the entity submitting  
18 the report.

19 The Suburban Bus Board and all participating entities shall  
20 hold an annual workshop open to the public in 2020 and every  
21 year thereafter on the state of supplier diversity to  
22 collaboratively seek solutions to structural impediments to  
23 achieving stated goals, including testimony from each

1 participating entity as well as subject matter experts and  
2 advocates. The Board shall publish a database on its website of  
3 the point of contact for each participating entity for supplier  
4 diversity, along with a list of certifications each entity  
5 recognizes from the information submitted in each annual  
6 report. The Board shall publish each annual report on its  
7 website and shall maintain each annual report for at least 5  
8 years.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
10 becoming law.
