SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 705/5.5 new

Amends the Illinois Police Training Act. Provides that the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board shall establish and administer a competitive grant program for county sheriffs to receive appropriate training to allow county sheriffs to provide enhanced security and threat assessments for schools. Provides that sheriffs provided funding to attend this training shall then assist in the training of other local law enforcement agencies located within that county to aid in the continued efforts to protect the children in our communities.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by 5 adding Section 5.5 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 705/5.5 new)

7 Sec. 5.5. Competitive grants for county sheriff's offices. In order to increase the number of schools that are equipped to 8 9 protect its students and faculty, the State finds no greater 10 responsibility than ensuring the safety of our children. The Board shall establish and administer a competitive grant 11 12 program for county sheriffs to receive appropriate training to allow county sheriffs to provide enhanced security and threat 13 14 assessments for schools. Sheriffs provided funding to attend this training shall then assist in the training of other local 15 16 law enforcement agencies located within that county to aid in 17 the continued efforts to protect the children in our 18 communities.
