SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

230 ILCS 40/65

Amends the Video Gaming Act. Requires a unit of government, including a home rule unit, to impose a fee for the operation of a video gaming terminal of \$1,000 per year (rather than prohibiting a non-home rule unit of government to impose any fee for the operation of a video gaming terminal in excess of \$25 per year). Limits home rule.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Video Gaming Act is amended by changing
5 Section 65 as follows:

6 (230 ILCS 40/65)

7 Sec. 65. Fees. A unit of government, including a home rule
8 unit, shall impose a fee for the operation of a video gaming
9 terminal of \$1,000 per year. A home rule unit may not impose a
10 fee in an amount other than that provided in this Section. This
11 Section is a denial and limitation of home rule powers and
12 functions under subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of
13 the Illinois Constitution. ~~A non home rule unit of government~~
14 ~~may not impose any fee for the operation of a video gaming~~
15 ~~terminal in excess of \$25 per year.~~
