1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 1. The amount of \$23,217,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019.

- 5 Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
- 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance
- 7 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois
- 8 for additional costs due to the establishment of minimum
- 9 retirement allowances pursuant to Sections 16-136.2 and 16-

- Section 25. The amount of \$245,487,000, or so much thereof
 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School
 Fund to the Public Teachers' Pension and Retirement Fund of
 Chicago for the state's contribution pursuant to paragraph (2)
 of subsection (d) of Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension
 Code.
