SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

510 ILCS 70/7.3 new 625 ILCS 5/11-1433 new

Amends the Humane Care for Animals Act and the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that no person shall lead or tether a companion animal from a moving motor vehicle or any device attached thereto.

- Sec. 11-1433. Leading animal from motor vehicle.
