## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 405/405-123 new

Amends the Department of Central Management Services Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that the Department of Central Management Services shall develop and implement plans to increase the number of individuals employed by State government who are in arrears on their child support payments. Provides that the Department shall prepare and revise annually an employment plan for individuals in arrears on child support payments, and shall do so in consultation with individuals and organizations informed on this subject. Provides reporting requirements concerning the employment plan for individuals in arrears on child support payments. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Central Management Services
Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by
adding Section 405-123 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 405/405-123 new)

Sec. 405-123. Employees with child support payments. The 8 9 Department shall develop and implement plans to increase the 10 number of individuals employed by State government who are in arrears on their child support payments. The Department shall 11 12 prepare and revise annually an employment plan for individuals 13 in arrears on child support payments, and shall do so in 14 consultation with individuals and organizations informed on this subject. By October 1 of each year, all State agencies 15 shall submit data to the Department showing how many 16 17 individuals in arrears on child support payments are employed by each State agency at that time. The Department shall submit 18 19 a report to the General Assembly by December 1 of each year 20 which includes submitted State agency data, a comparison of 21 that data to prior years' data, if available, and details on 22 each State agency's activities in implementing the employment plan for individuals in arrears on child support payments. 23
