SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

70 ILCS 3605/54 new 30 ILCS 805/8.44 new

Amends the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act. Provides that the Chicago Transit Authority shall, no later than July 1, 2021, establish a program, similar to the U-Pass program, for allowing persons 18 or younger use the Authority's buses and trains for transportation to youth programs or youth services. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement from the State.

The Authority shall, no later than July 1, 2021, establish a
program, similar to the U-Pass program, for allowing persons 18

transportation to youth programs or youth services.

Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding Section 8.44 as follows:

<u>Sec. 8.44. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8</u>
of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
the 101st General Assembly.
