#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 505/5.06 new

Amends the Children and Family Services Act. Provides that, to ensure that the education of a youth in care is not interrupted after the youth is placed in a residential treatment facility and held in the facility beyond medical necessity, on the date a youth is initially admitted to a residential treatment facility, the Department of Children and Family Services must update its records and list the address of the residential treatment facility as the official address of the youth in care so that the youth is eligible to receive education services from the school district in which the residential treatment facility is located, including services provided under a remote educational program as defined in the School Code.

4 Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended  
5 by adding Section 5.06 as follows:

7 Sec. 5.06. Update residential address information; youth  
8 in care. To ensure that the education of a youth in care is not  
9 interrupted after the youth is placed in a residential  
10 treatment facility and held in the facility beyond medical  
11 necessity, on the date a youth is initially admitted to a  
12 residential treatment facility, the Department must update its  
13 records and list the address of the residential treatment  
14 facility as the official address of the youth in care so that  
15 the youth is eligible to receive education services from the  
16 school district in which the residential treatment facility is  
17 located, including services provided under a remote  
18 educational program as defined in Section 10-29 of the School  
19 Code.
