SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 112/17 new

Amends the Equal Pay Act of 2003. Requires employers to disclose to any person who receives compensation from the employer, whether as an employee or as a contractor, pay scales for all positions for which the employer pays compensation. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Equal Pay Act of 2003 is amended by adding
- 5 Section 17 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 112/17 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 17. Disclosure of pay scales.</u>
- 8 (a) An employer must disclose to any person to whom the
- 9 employer pays salary, wages, or other compensation for
- 10 performing services, whether as an employee or as a contractor,
- 11 the pay scale for all positions for which the employer pays
- 12 compensation.
- 13 (b) The required disclosure must be made to all persons
- receiving compensation before January 1, 2021 no later than
- 15 January 1, 2021. The disclosure to persons who first receive
- 16 compensation after December 31, 2020 must be made at the time
- the person is hired.
- 18 (c) If pay scales are revised, the changes in the pay
- 19 scales must be disclosed when the revisions are effective.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 21 becoming law.
