SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2805/2.14 new

Amends the Department of Veterans' Affairs Act. Requires the Department of Veterans' Affairs to create a mental health pilot program to provide supportive services to active duty service members, veterans, and their families. Contains requirements for the pilot program. Requires the Department to provide follow-up interviews with families who participate in the pilot program to determine the effectiveness of services and classes offered under the pilot program. Provides that the Department may adopt any rules necessary to implement the pilot program.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Department of Veterans' Affairs Act is 5 amended by adding Section 2.14 as follows:

7 Sec. 2.14. Mental health pilot program. The Department shall create a mental health pilot program to provide 8 9 supportive services to active duty service members, veterans, 10 and their families. The pilot program shall offer informational services and counseling to families on how best to support 11 12 service members during their deployment and upon their reentry to civilian life. The pilot program shall also provide a 13 14 general education course to family members on how to help service members and veterans adjust to the physical and mental 15 16 challenges they might face after returning home from active duty. The Department shall provide follow-up interviews with 17 families who participate in the pilot program to determine the 18 19 effectiveness of services and classes offered under the pilot program. The Department may adopt any rules necessary to 20 21 implement the pilot program.
