## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2605/2605-325

was 20 ILCS 2605/55a in part

Amends the Department of State Police Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Requires the Illinois State Police to furnish conviction information, pursuant to a fingerprint-based criminal history records check under the School Code, within 30 days after receipt of a request from a school board or regional superintendent of schools. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of State Police Law of the Civil

  Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section
- 6 2605-325 as follows:

- Sec. 2605-325. Conviction information for school board or 8 9 regional superintendent. On request of a school board or 10 superintendent of schools, to 11 fingerprint-based criminal history records check pursuant to Section 10-21.9 or 34-18.5 of the School Code. The Department 12 shall furnish the conviction information within 30 days after 13 14 receipt of the request to the president of the school board of the school district that has requested the information or, if 15 16 the information was requested by the regional superintendent,
