A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and  
8 contingent expenses of the Law Enforcement Training Standards  
9 Board:

11 Payable from the Traffic and Criminal

12 Conviction Surcharge Fund:

13 For Personal Services .....2,193,400

14 For State Contributions to State

15 Employees' Retirement System .....1,202,700

13 Grant Fund:

14 For grants to units of  
 15 local government in Illinois  
 16 related to installing video cameras  
 17 in law enforcement vehicles and  
 18 training law enforcement officers  
 19 in the operation of the cameras in  
 20 accordance with statutory provisions  
 21 of the Law Enforcement Camera

23 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much thereof  
 24 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes

1 hereinafter named, is appropriated to the Law Enforcement  
2 Training Standards Board as follows:

3 GRANTS-IN-AID

4 Payable from the Traffic and Criminal  
5 Conviction Surcharge Fund:

6 For payment of and/or reimbursement  
7 of training and training services  
8 in accordance with statutory provisions .....16,200,000

9 Section 15. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
11 Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for  
12 deposit into the Traffic and Criminal Conviction Surcharge  
13 Fund. No portion of this appropriation shall be deposited into  
14 the Traffic and Criminal Conviction Surcharge Fund unless and  
15 until it is approved in writing by the Governor.

16 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
17 2020.
