Section 10. The amount of \$338,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amusement Ride and Patron Safety Fund to the Department of Labor for operational expenses associated with the administration of The Amusement

6 Ride and Attraction Safety Act.

Section 15. The amount of \$650,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Labor and Day and Temporary Labor Services Enforcement Fund to the Department of Labor for operational expenses associated with the administration of The Child Labor Law Act and the Day and Temporary Labor Services Act.

Section 20. The amount of \$150,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Employee Classification Fund to the Department of Labor for operational expenses associated with the administration of The Employee Classification Act.

Section 25. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wage Theft Enforcement Fund to the Department of Labor for operational expenses associated with the administration of The Illinois Wage Payment and Collection Act.

- Section 30. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof 1 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of 3 Labor Federal Trust Fund to the Department of Labor for all costs associated with promoting and enforcing the occupational 4 5 safety and health administration state program for public sector worksites. 6
- 7 Section 35. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Industrial 8 9 Services Fund to the Department of Labor for administrative and 10 other expenses, for the Occupational Safety and Health 11 Administration Program, including refunds and prior year costs.
- 12 Section 40. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Labor 14 Federal Indirect Cost Fund to the Department of Labor for all 15 costs associated with OSHA Indirect Costs.
- 16 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 17 2020.
