Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes 7 hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General Revenue 8 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and 9 contingent expenses:

5 Section 15. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 7 to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to the 8 alternative schools network and other providers.

9 Section 20. The sum of \$150,000 or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 11 the Illinois Community College Board for support of the P-20 12 Council.

13 Section 25. The sum of \$60,200, or so much thereof as may 14 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 15 the Illinois Community College Board for awarding scholarships 16 to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's Challenge Program.

17 Section 30. The sum of \$13,265,400, or so much thereof as 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 19 to the Illinois Community College Board for the City Colleges 20 of Chicago for educational-related expenses. Section 35. The sum of \$663,300, or so much thereof as may
 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
 the Illinois Community College Board for the City Colleges of
 Chicago for education-related expenses if, but only if, Public
 Act 101-0008 takes effect.

6 Section 40. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 7 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the 8 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community College Board 9 for distribution to qualifying public community colleges for 10 the purposes specified:
