1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund to meet its

8 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

9 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 11 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the

Section 15. The sum of \$27,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for deposit into the Illinois Prepaid Tuition Trust Fund if, but only if, Public

- Section 95. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and Maintenance.
- Section 100. The sum of \$1,000,000 or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund for
 costs associated with the Illinois Designated Account Purchase
 Program.
- 12 Section 105. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student 14 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund for 15 distribution as necessary for the following: for payment of collection agency fees associated with collection activities 16 17 for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default Aversion Fee 18 reversals, and for distributions as necessary and provided for 19 under the Federal Higher Education Act.

- 6 Section 115. The sum of \$190,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student 7 8 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for 9 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for 10 quarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection 11 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under 12 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default Aversion 13 Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for other 14 15 distributions as necessary and provided for under the Federal 16 Higher Education Act.
- 17 Section 120. The sum of \$13,000,000, or so much thereof 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student 19 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for allowable uses of federal grant funds related 20 21 to college access, outreach, and training, including but not 22 limited to funds received under the federal Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Program. 23

- Section 125. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as 1
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student 2
- 3 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
- Commission for the John R. Justice Student Loan Repayment 4
- 5 Program.
- 6 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 7 1, 2020.
