HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Chester 4 Slaughter of Chicago, who passed away on December 23, 2018; and

5 WHEREAS, Chester Slaughter was born and raised on the South 6 Side of Chicago and was a successful product of the Chicago 7 Public School system; and

8 WHEREAS, Chester Slaughter went on to attend Tennessee 9 State University (TSU), earning his undergraduate degrees in 10 political science and history in 1965; inspired by the civil 11 rights movement and determined to make a difference in the 12 lives of African Americans, he furthered his education at 13 Howard University School of Law in Washington, D.C.; and

14 WHEREAS, Chester Slaughter participated in the Howard Law 15 Journal and received his Juris Doctorate in 1968; while 16 attending law school, he met the love of his life, Ruth Willis; 17 and

18 WHEREAS, Chester Slaughter's achievement as an outstanding 19 defense attorney propelled him to become a trailblazer in the 20 legal community and a vital cornerstone of four notable law 21 firms; and 1 WHEREAS, Chester Slaughter's diverse career included working within the government and public sectors, where he 2 3 served as a supervising Cook County State's Attorney, as 4 General Counsel for the Maywood Park District, and as a hearing 5 officer for the Cook County Metropolitan Water Reclamation 6 District; he will forever be remembered for his remarkable 46-year career as a distinguished attorney, political advisor, 7 8 community advocate, and mentor; therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE 10 HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 11 we mourn the passing of Chester Slaughter and extend our 12 sincere condolences to his family, friends, and all who knew 13 and loved him; and be it further
