HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of NBA
4 superstar Kobe Bryant and his daughter, Gianna, on January 26,
5 2020; and

6 WHEREAS, Kobe Bryant was born in Philadelphia,
7 Pennsylvania to Joe and Pamela Cox Bryant on August 23, 1978;
8 when he was six, his family moved to Italy, and he spent many
9 of his formative years there learning Italian and playing
10 soccer; he returned to the U.S. during the summers to play in
11 basketball summer leagues; he earned national recognition
12 while playing basketball at Lower Merion High School in
13 Ardmore, Pennsylvania, where he played on the varsity
14 basketball team as a freshman; and

15 WHEREAS, Kobe Bryant joined the NBA directly from high
16 school and played his entire 20-season professional career with
17 the Los Angeles Lakers, his favorite team while growing up; and

18 WHEREAS, During his career, Kobe Bryant won five NBA
19 championships (2000-2002, 2009, 2010); he was an 18-time
20 All-Star, 15-time member of the All-NBA Team, and 12-time
21 member of the All-Defensive Team; he was named the 2008 NBA
22 Most Valuable Player and was a two-time NBA Finals MVP; he led

1 the NBA in scoring during two seasons, ranks fourth on the
2 league's all-time regular season scoring, and ranks fourth on
3 the all-time postseason scoring list; he is also a two-time
4 Gold Medal Winner with the U.S. Men's Basketball Team (2008
5 Beijing, 2012 London); he is widely regarded as one of the
6 greatest basketball players of all time; and

7 WHEREAS, Kobe Bryant scored a season-high 60 points against
8 Utah in his last NBA game on April 13, 2016, outscoring the
9 entire Jazz team 23-21 in the fourth quarter in a Lakers'
10 victory; he became the oldest player to score 60 or more points
11 in a game at 37 years and 234 days old; and

12 WHEREAS, Kobe Bryant said that he wanted more out of life
13 than just a successful basketball career; he married Vanessa
14 Laine at St. Edward the Confessor Catholic Church in Dana
15 Point, California on April 18, 2001, and they had four
16 daughters, Natalia, Gianna, Vanessa, and Capri; his daughter,
17 Gianna, had a passion for basketball, and he enjoyed sharing
18 his love of basketball with her; and

19 WHEREAS, Gianna Maria Onore Bryant, also referred to as
20 Gigi, was born on May 1, 2006; she considered her Kobe a role
21 model and cited him as a reason she wanted to play in the WNBA;
22 she played youth basketball for the Mamba Sports Academy, where
23 she was coached by her father; she wanted to play college

1 basketball at the University of Connecticut and regularly
2 attended UConn, WNBA, and Lakers games with Kobe; she had a
3 very close relationship with her father and was usually by his
4 side; and

5 WHEREAS, Kobe Bryant was the official ambassador for
6 After-School All-Stars, an American non-profit organization
7 that provides comprehensive after-school programs to children;
8 he also started the Kobe Bryant China Fund, which raises money
9 within China for education and health programs; on November 4,
10 2010, he was part of a group that presented a \$1 million check
11 to the Call of Duty Endowment, a nonprofit organization that
12 helps veterans transition to civilian careers after their
13 military service has ended; and

14 WHEREAS, Together with his wife, Kobe Bryant founded the
15 Kobe and Vanessa Bryant Family Foundation, a charity dedicated
16 to improving the lives of youth and families in need; the
17 foundation supports programs that strengthen communities and
18 promote mutual understanding among people around the world; and

19 WHEREAS, In 2018, Kobe Bryant became the first African
20 American to win the Academy Award for Best Animated Short Film
21 and the first former professional athlete to be nominated and
22 to win an Academy Award in any category for his film Dear
23 Basketball; on October 23, 2018, his book, The Mamba Mentality:

1 How I Play, was published, and most recently, he was working on
2 a children's book aimed at inspiring underprivileged children;
3 therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
5 HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
6 we mourn the passing of Kobe Bryant and his daughter, Gianna,
7 and extend our sincere condolences to their family, friends,
8 and all who knew and loved them; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That we declare January 25, 2020 as "Kobe Bryant
10 Day" in the State of Illinois; and be it further

11 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
12 presented to the family of Kobe and Gianna Bryant as a symbol
13 of our deepest sympathy.
