1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, Illinois is coping with a global outbreak of the 3 coronavirus, the COVID-19 pandemic, which has led to widespread 4 illness and death and has disrupted the lives of all 5 Illinoisans; and
- WHEREAS, The Governor of Illinois has issued a series of
 emergency executive orders in response to the COVID-19
 pandemic; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Illinois public and private colleges have faced 10 unprecedented financial challenges, spending hundreds of 11 millions of dollars in unbudgeted funds supporting their 12 students, faculty, and staff; these colleges have also had to 13 reduce programs in addition to laying off and furloughing 14 workers; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Many Illinois public and private college students 16 are African American or Latinx and first-generation college 17 students, meaning they are the first in their family to go to 18 college, and they are facing an urgent situation because of 19 family financial pressures; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic 21 Security (CARES) Act passed by Congress brought only minimal

- 1 relief to Illinois public and private colleges and universities
- for investments in campus safety, including social distancing,
- 3 sanitation, and diagnostic testing measures; therefore, be it
- 4 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE 5 HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 6 we urge the U.S. Congress to approve a COVID-19 relief package of at least \$120 billion that includes funding for public and 7 8 private colleges and universities for student and 9 institutional needs, reopening costs, technology costs, and 10 lost revenue due to the pandemic and also includes limited 11 liability protection for these institutions; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to each member of the Illinois Congressional Delegation and the President of the United States.
