1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 946

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 946 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 5.891 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.891 new)

7 Sec. 5.891. The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund.

8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
9 changing Section 3-699.14 as follows:

10 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14)

11 Sec. 3-699.14. Universal special license plates.

12 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the  
13 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications  
14 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue

1 Universal special license plates to residents of Illinois on  
2 behalf of organizations that have been authorized by the  
3 General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special license  
4 plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by the  
5 Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized  
6 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this Section.  
7 When applying for a Universal special license plate the  
8 applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the  
9 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a  
10 decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record  
11 of that organization and that organization shall remain  
12 affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered,  
13 revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization  
14 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and  
15 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the  
16 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct from  
17 any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal,  
18 sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal  
19 special license plate other than a decal authorized by the  
20 General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal  
21 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be  
22 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,  
23 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the  
24 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates  
25 issued under this Section shall expire according to the  
26 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

1           (b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special  
2 license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the  
3 Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required to  
4 designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of  
5 Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for the  
6 application of a decal to the plate. Organizations authorized  
7 by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special  
8 license plates shall comply with rules adopted by the Secretary  
9 governing the requirements for and approval of Universal  
10 special license plate decals. The Secretary may, in his or her  
11 discretion, allow Universal special license plates to be issued  
12 as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section  
13 3-405.1 of this Code. The Secretary of State must make a  
14 version of the special registration plates authorized under  
15 this Section in a form appropriate for motorcycles and  
16 autocycles.

17           (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate, the  
18 General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee is  
19 to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged, the  
20 amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed. When  
21 necessary, the authorizing language shall create a special fund  
22 in the State treasury into which fees may be deposited for an  
23 authorized Universal special license plate. Additional fees  
24 may only be charged if the fee is to be paid over to a State  
25 agency or to a charitable entity that is in compliance with the  
26 registration and reporting requirements of the Charitable

1 Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act. Any charitable  
2 entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal special license  
3 plates shall annually provide the Secretary of State a letter  
4 of compliance issued by the Attorney General verifying that the  
5 entity is in compliance with the Charitable Trust Act and the  
6 Solicitation for Charity Act.

7 (d) Upon original issuance and for each registration  
8 renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration  
9 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional  
10 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license  
11 plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the  
12 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the  
13 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State  
14 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into  
15 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the  
16 organization to issue decals for Universal special license  
17 plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed  
18 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General  
19 Assembly.

20 (e) The following organizations may issue decals for  
21 Universal special license plates with the original and renewal  
22 fees and fee distribution as follows:

23 (1) The Illinois Department of Natural Resources.

24 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
25 Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund and \$15 to the Secretary  
26 of State Special License Plate Fund.

1 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Roadside Monarch  
2 Habitat Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special  
3 License Plate Fund.

4 (2) Illinois Veterans' Homes.

5 (A) Original issuance: \$26, which shall be  
6 deposited into the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

7 (B) Renewal: \$26, which shall be deposited into the  
8 Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund.

9 (3) The Illinois Department of Human Services for  
10 volunteerism decals.

11 (A) Original issuance: \$25, which shall be  
12 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License  
13 Plate Fund.

14 (B) Renewal: \$25, which shall be deposited into the  
15 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

16 (4) The Illinois Department of Public Health.

17 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
18 Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the Secretary  
19 of State Special License Plate Fund.

20 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Prostate Cancer  
21 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special  
22 License Plate Fund.

23 (5) Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

24 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
25 Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund and \$15 to the  
26 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

1 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Horsemen's  
2 Council of Illinois Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of  
3 State Special License Plate Fund.

4 (6) The Illinois Department of Human Services for  
5 pediatric cancer awareness decals.

6 (A) Original issuance: \$25; with \$10 to the  
7 Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund and \$15 to the  
8 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

9 (B) Renewal: \$25; with \$23 to the Pediatric Cancer  
10 Awareness Fund and \$2 to the Secretary of State Special  
11 License Plate Fund.

12 (f) The following funds are created as special funds in the  
13 State treasury:

14 (1) The Roadside Monarch Habitat Fund. All moneys to be  
15 paid as grants to the Illinois Department of Natural  
16 Resources to fund roadside monarch and other pollinator  
17 habitat development, enhancement, and restoration projects  
18 in this State.

19 (2) The Prostate Cancer Awareness Fund. All moneys to  
20 be paid as grants to the Prostate Cancer Foundation of  
21 Chicago.

22 (3) The Horsemen's Council of Illinois Fund. All moneys  
23 shall be paid as grants to the Horsemen's Council of  
24 Illinois.

25 (4) The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All moneys to  
26 be paid as grants to the University of Illinois Cancer

1           Center for pediatric cancer treatment and research.
