

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by  
5 adding Section 105 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/105 new)

7 Sec. 105. Military college; credit transfer.

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the  
9 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any  
10 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University  
11 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

12 Section 10. The Southern Illinois University Management  
13 Act is amended by adding Section 90 as follows:

14 (110 ILCS 520/90 new)

15 Sec. 90. Military college; credit transfer.

16 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the  
17 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any  
18 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University  
19 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

20 Section 15. The Chicago State University Law is amended by

1 adding Section 5-200 as follows:

2 (110 ILCS 660/5-200 new)

3 Sec. 5-200. Military college; credit transfer.

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the

5 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any

6 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University

7 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

8 Section 20. The Eastern Illinois University Law is amended

9 by adding Section 10-200 as follows:

10 (110 ILCS 665/10-200 new)

11 Sec. 10-200. Military college; credit transfer.

12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the

13 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any

14 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University

15 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

16 Section 25. The Governors State University Law is amended

17 by adding Section 15-200 as follows:

18 (110 ILCS 670/15-200 new)

19 Sec. 15-200. Military college; credit transfer.

20 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the

21 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any

1 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University  
2 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

3 Section 30. The Illinois State University Law is amended by  
4 adding Section 20-205 as follows:

5 (110 ILCS 675/20-205 new)

6 Sec. 20-205. Military college; credit transfer.  
7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the  
8 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any  
9 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University  
10 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

11 Section 35. The Northeastern Illinois University Law is  
12 amended by adding Section 25-200 as follows:

13 (110 ILCS 680/25-200 new)

14 Sec. 25-200. Military college; credit transfer.  
15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the  
16 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any  
17 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University  
18 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

19 Section 40. The Northern Illinois University Law is amended  
20 by adding Section 30-210 as follows:

1 (110 ILCS 685/30-210 new)

2 Sec. 30-210. Military college; credit transfer.  
3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the  
4 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any  
5 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University  
6 from a senior military college or a military junior college.

7 Section 45. The Western Illinois University Law is amended  
8 by adding Section 35-205 as follows:

9 (110 ILCS 690/35-205 new)

10 Sec. 35-205. Military college; credit transfer.  
11 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, beginning with the  
12 2020-2021 academic year, the University must accept any  
13 academic credits from a student who transfers to the University  
14 from a senior military college or a military junior college.
