Amend Senate Bill 2151 on page 13, by replacing line 7 with the following: 3 "nurses based on the comprehensive nursing assessment that 4 includes, but is not limited to: 5 6 (A) the stability and condition of the patient; (B) the potential for harm; 8 (C) the complexity of the nursing intervention or task to be delegated; 9 (D) the predictability of outcomes; and 10 (E) the competency of the individual to whom the 11 12 nursing intervention or task is delegated;"; and on page 14, immediately below line 25, by inserting the 13 14 following: "(2.5) A registered professional nurse from delegating 15 16 work requiring nursing knowledge, assessment, judgment,

inference, decision making (including medication

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- 2 evaluation of a plan of care to unlicensed non-nurse
- 3 personnel.".
