SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-609.2 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Allows the Secretary of State to issue Law Enforcement Medal of Honor license plates. Provides that the plates shall display the Law Enforcement Medal of Honor.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
5 Section 3-609.2 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-609.2 new)

7 Sec. 3-609.2. Law Enforcement Medal of Honor license
8 plates.

9 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
10 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications
11 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue Law
12 Enforcement Medal of Honor license plates to residents of this
13 State who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the
14 Secretary. The special Law Enforcement Medal of Honor plate
15 issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger
16 vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles
17 of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds.
18 Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the
19 staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1.

20 (b) The plates shall display the Law Enforcement Medal of
21 Honor. In all other respects, the design, color, and format of
22 the plates shall be within the discretion of the Secretary. The
23 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be

1 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with
2 Section 3-405.1. The plates are not required to designate "Land
3 of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412.
4 The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements
5 and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe
6 stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.
