

## 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 SB3546

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

415 ILCS 5/9.18 new

Amends the Environmental Protection Act. Provides that any facility that emits a carcinogen in this State must have a CAAPP permit. Defines "carcinogen". Effective January 1, 2021.

- 4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
- 5 adding Section 9.18 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 5/9.18 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 9.18. Carcinogens; CAAPP permit.</u>
- 8 (a) Any facility that emits a carcinogen in this State must
- 9 have a CAAPP permit.
- 10 (b) In this Section, "carcinogen" means a substance listed
- 11 under Group A of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's
- 12 carcinogen risk assessment guidelines.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
- 14 1, 2021.
