Makes appropriations for the Illinois State Board of Education and teacher retirement contributions for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, as follows:

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The amount of \$24,508,600, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education to meet its  
8 operational expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
9 2020.

10 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois State Board  
12 of Education for Evidence-Based Funding, provided for in  
13 Section 18-8.15 of the School Code:

14	Payable from the Education Assistance Fund.....	622,101,200
15	Payable from the Common School Fund.....	3,213,015,600
16	Payable from the General Revenue Fund.....	2,921,834,200
17	Payable from the Fund for the Advancement	
18	of Education.....	657,862,200

19 Section 10. The sum of 44,663,600, or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance

1 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for Evidence-  
2 Based Funding, provided for in section 18-8.15 of the School  
3 Code if, but only if, Public Act 101-0008 takes effect.

4 Section 15. The sum of 57,336,400 or so much thereof as may  
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
6 the Illinois State Board of Education for Evidence-Based  
7 Funding, provided for in section 18-8.15 of the School Code if,  
8 but only if, Public Act 101-0008 takes effect.

9 Section 20. The sum of 48,000,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fund for the  
11 Advancement of Education to the Illinois State Board of  
12 Education for Evidence-Based Funding, provided for in section  
13 18-8.15 of the School Code if, but only if, Public Act 101-  
14 0008 takes effect.

15 Section 25. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State  
17 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and  
18 not, under any circumstances, for personal services  
19 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs, are  
20 appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for the  
21 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020:

12 Section 30. The sum of 17,908,000, or so much thereof as  
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
 14 to the Illinois State Board of Education for Disabled Student  
 15 Transportation Reimbursement if, but only if, Public Act 101-  
 16 0008 takes effect.

17 Section 35. The sum of 21,440,000, or so much thereof as  
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
 19 to the Illinois State Board of Education for Disabled Student  
 20 Tuition, Private Tuition if, but only if, Public Act 101-0008  
 21 takes effect.

22 Section 40. The sum of 965,400, or so much thereof as may

1 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
 2 the Illinois State Board of Education for Transportation-  
 3 Regular/Vocational Common School Transportation Reimbursement,  
 4 29-5 of the School Code if, but only if, Public Act 101-0008  
 5 takes effect.

6 Section 45. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
 7 may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois State Board  
 8 of Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020:

4 Section 50. The amount of \$650,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
6 to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
7 associated with the Community Residential Services Authority.

8 Section 55. The amount of \$53,200,000, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
10 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for Student  
11 Assessments, including Bilingual Assessments.

12 Section 60. The amount of \$475,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
14 to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
15 associated with Educator Misconduct Hearings and  
16 Investigations.

17 Section 65. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof  
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
19 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
20 associated with Educators Rising, including but not limited to,  
21 a grant to Educators Rising of Phi Delta Kappa.

1           Section 70. The amount of \$12,100,000, or so much thereof  
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 3 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for District  
 4 Intervention Funding for East St. Louis District 189 and North  
 5 Chicago CUSD 187, at the approximate costs below:

6           For East St. Louis District 189 .....6,050,000  
 7           For North Chicago CUSD 187 .....6,050,000

8           Section 75. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof  
 9 as may be necessarily, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 10 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
 11 associated with the Community Partnerships for Student Health  
 12 and Well-Being Pilot Program including, but not limited to,  
 13 grants and amounts to be solely determined by the State  
 14 Superintendent to City of Chicago School District 299 and/or  
 15 any of the Regional Offices of Education in the six regional  
 16 service areas.

17           Section 80. The amount of \$7,996,000, or so much thereof  
 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
 19 Assistance Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for  
 20 all costs associated with Golden Apple Programs, including, but  
 21 not limited to, a grant to the Golden Apple Foundation and  
 22 financial assistance to scholars identified by the Golden Apple



1 Foundation, but not including any costs associated with the  
2 Golden Apple Accelerators Program.

3 Section 85. The amount of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
5 Assistance Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for  
6 all costs associated with the Golden Apple Accelerators  
7 Program, including, but not limited to, a grant to the Golden  
8 Apple Foundation and financial assistance to accelerators as  
9 identified by the Golden Apple Foundation.

## ARTICLE 2

11 Section 5. The amount of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Teacher  
13 Certificate Fee Revolving Fund to the Illinois State Board of  
14 Education for all costs authorized by the Educator Licensure  
15 Article of the School Code, including refunds.

16 Section 10. The amount of \$8,484,800, or so much thereof  
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Board of  
18 Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the Illinois State  
19 Board of Education for expenditures by the Board in accordance  
20 with grants, gifts or donations that the Board has received or  
21 may receive from any source, public or private, in support of

1 projects that are within the lawful powers of the Board,  
2 including refunds.

3 Section 15. The amount of \$8,150,000, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Board of  
5 Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the Illinois State  
6 Board of Education for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

7 Section 20. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the School District  
9 Emergency Financial Assistance Fund for use by the Illinois  
10 State Board of Education as provided in Section 1B-8 of the  
11 School Code.

12 Section 25. The amount of \$2,208,900, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE Teacher  
14 Certificate Institute Fund to the Illinois State Board of  
15 Education for costs authorized by the School Code, including  
16 refunds.

17 Section 30. The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the After-School Rescue  
19 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for its ordinary  
20 and contingent expenses.

1 Section 35. The amount of \$600,000, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the School  
3 Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education  
4 for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

5 Section 40. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Temporary  
7 Relocation Expenses Revolving Grant Fund for use by the  
8 Illinois State Board of Education as provided in Section 2-  
9 3.77 of the School Code.

10 Section 45. The amount of \$1,050,000, or so much thereof  
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Board of  
12 Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the Illinois State  
13 Board of Education for all costs associated with its Charter  
14 School Department per 105 ILCS 5/27A-7.5.

15 Section 50. The amount of \$11,400,000, or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Personal Property  
17 Tax Replacement Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education  
18 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 for Regional  
19 Superintendents' and Assistants' Compensation and Related  
20 Benefits.

21 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the Personal  
2 Property Tax Replacement Fund to the Illinois State Board of  
3 Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020:

7 Section 60. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State

12 appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for the  
13 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020:

21 Section 65. The amount of \$600,000, or so much thereof as  
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Board of  
23 Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the Illinois State

1 Board of Education for Grant Accountability and Transparency  
2 Act and Budgeting for Results Initiatives.

3 Section 70. The amount of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the School STEAM  
5 Grant Program Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for  
6 the School STEAM Grant Program.

7 ARTICLE 3

8 Section 5. The amount of \$19,904,700, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE Federal  
10 Department of Agriculture Fund to the Illinois State Board of  
11 Education for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

12 Section 10. The amount of \$2,900,000, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE Federal  
14 Agency Services Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education  
15 for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

16 Section 15. The amount of \$50,869,800, or so much  
17 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE  
18 Federal Department of Education Fund to the Illinois State  
19 Board of Education for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

1 Section 20. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
2 may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois State Board  
3 of Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020:

3 ARTICLE 4

4 Section 1. The sum of \$5,140,336,721, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School  
6 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois  
7 for the State's contribution, as provided by law.

8 Section 5. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may  
9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
10 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois  
11 for additional costs due to the establishment of minimum  
12 retirement allowances pursuant to Sections 16-136.2 and 16-  
13 136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code, as amended.

14 Section 10. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may  
15 be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund to  
16 the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer  
17 contributions required by the State as an employer of teachers  
18 described under subsection (e) or subsection (f) of Section 16-  
19 158 of the Illinois Pension Code.

20 Section 15. The amount of \$89,857,069, or so much thereof



1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
2 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois  
3 for deposit into the Teacher Health Insurance Security Fund as  
4 the state's contribution for teachers' health insurance.

5 Section 20. The amount of \$12,333,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School  
7 Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement Fund  
8 of Chicago for the state's contribution pursuant to subsection  
9 (c) of Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension Code.

10 Section 25. The amount of \$254,560,000, or so much thereof  
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School  
12 Fund to the Public Teachers' Pension and Retirement Fund of  
13 Chicago for the state's contribution pursuant to paragraph (2)  
14 of subsection (d) of Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension  
15 Code.

## ARTICLE 99

17 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July  
18 1, 2020.
