SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. I, Sec. 22.1 new

Proposes to amend the Bill of Rights Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that neither the State nor any political subdivision of the State may enact or enforce any law, ordinance, rule, regulation, or the like that by design or application prohibits, restricts, tends to restrict, or regulates the use of union security agreements between an employer and labor organization or other rights to unionize. Effective upon being declared adopted.

3 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL
4 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
5 CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the
6 electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general
7 election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of
8 this resolution a proposition to add Section 22.1 to Article I
9 of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

11 BILL OF RIGHTS

13 SECTION 22.1. RIGHTS TO UNIONIZE

14 Neither the State nor any political subdivision of the
15 State may enact or enforce any law, ordinance, rule,
16 regulation, or the like that by design or application
17 prohibits, restricts, tends to restrict, or regulates the use
18 of union security agreements between an employer and labor
19 organization or other rights to unionize.

20 SCHEDULE

21 This Constitutional Amendment takes effect upon being
22 declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois

1 Constitutional Amendment Act.
