WHEREAS, Allan Mueller was born in Taylor Ridge on November 17, 1923; he studied at the University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign, where he met his wife, Gloria, whom he married in 1947; and

WHEREAS, Allan Mueller was a professor of agricultural economics at the University of Illinois; he loved teaching and interacting with his students; he was particularly proud of developing a popular Ag Business Organization and Accounting course that he taught for 15 years; he did extensive Extension work, developed farm record systems, taught courses, and mentored more than 25 graduate students until his retirement in 1984; and

WHEREAS, Allan Mueller, along with his wife, continued his involvement with the Ag Department by providing scholarship money for incoming students who plan to study agriculture; he was involved with Nabor House Fraternity, of which he was a founding member as a student in the 1940s; during his career and in retirement, he traveled extensively with his wife; they
